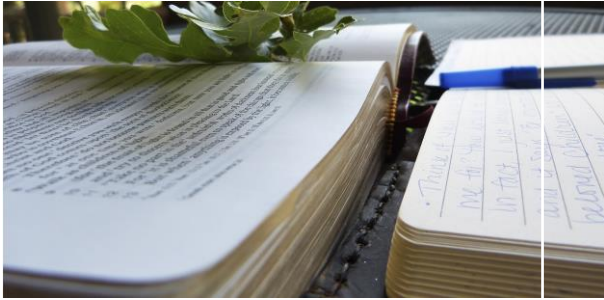


## Fall Bible Study
